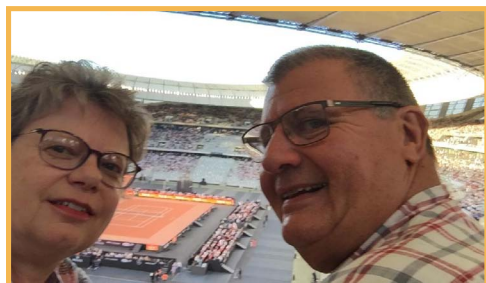


Dear Rotarians and Rotary Family,

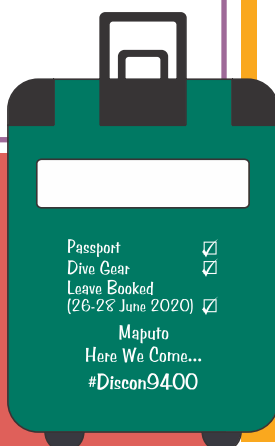

THE WHEELCHAIR FOUNDATION (UK) VISITS CLUBS IN REGION 6 (LIMPOPO) - January 2020

This was a combined project initiated by Rotary Haenertsburg (with a district grant) in which 5 clubs in Region 6 (Limpopo) pooled their funds. A total of 110 wheelchairs were ordered and shipped from the Wheelchair Foundation in the UK for distribution.

The clubs involved were: Louis Trichardt, Polokwane, Tzaneen, Pietersburg 100 and Haenertsburg.

HOW IS THE NPC STRUCTURED IN DISTRICT 9400?

District 9400 conducts its affairs in a registered non profit company all in terms of the South African Companies Act. The NPC has seven directors who govern the affairs of the district. There are four operational directors which are what we refer to as the "Quad" viz:

- > Immediate Past District Governor (in the interest of continuity)
- > District Governor (the CEO of the district and the RI representative)
- > District Governor Elect (future CEO and RI representative)
- > District Governor Nominee (also future CEO and RI representative)

These four directors operate the same as it was in the past when the District was an association of clubs. Given their great responsibility, they appoint two specialists to assist them with carrying out their duties such as legal, financial, governance, IT, etc. The seventh director is the Chairman of the District Programs NPC. Each director is in office for one year. The Quad hold office for one year each and then move on i.e. DGE becomes DG and DG becomes IPDG and so on. Each year the Quad reconsider the two specialist directors on the board in terms of what skills they need on the board. The seven directors at their first meeting every year appoint the Chairman. It is to be appreciated that the Chairman is not the CEO, he/she is elected to chair the meeting, draft up agendas, ensure governance, compliance, etc.

The District Programs NPC is a vehicle that focuses on the policies, procedures and governance of all Youth programs, Friendship exchange, Rotaract, etc. The assistant governors are there to assist the district governor of the day much the same as it has been in the past.
